

Parking Restriction for Live-On Freshman

- West side lots currently impacted daily
- Climate Action Plan
- New residential facility being built will host freshman
- Event parking needed for Viejas for which P12 was built
- We do not restrict student parking during events who have a live-on permit
- We have grown our transportation options on campus – two of which are subsidized
 - Trolley / Bus
 - Zipcar – Rents to 18 yrs.
 - Zimride
- Other universities that restrict freshman parking are: UCSD, Cal Poly, Stanford
- An Exemption Policy will be developed to waive the requirement when appropriate for ADA, Health, and other compelling needs.

Changes to Senate Policy File 4.0

- It is a CVC infraction to ride motorized scooters or skateboards:
 - Without a helmet
 - Must operate on streets limited to 25 mph (scooters) or 35 mph (skateboards)
 - University Police Department prefers the issuance of administrative citations
- Motorized skateboards and scooters are present and we have no reference in the policy file
- Policy File (attached)
- 4.7 Language is ambiguous regarding motorized scooters – is referring to Vespa/moped like vehicles
- Administrative citations can still be issued as many of the motorized scooters and skateboards are not be ridden on the bike lane
- The sustainable transportation managers on campus are working with the scooter companies to look at limiting the motorized scooters to only be permitted to be ridden to campus and to be parked at appropriate zones in the periphery of campus

We are forming a shared governance parking & transportation committee and we are requesting senate representation. We would be discussing the above topics and obtaining input to make necessary recommendations. We are asking for 1-2 senators to sit on the committee and we would like the committee to be ongoing. We would meet monthly to start and then quarterly as needed for future topics.
