I approve the following actions from the Senate meeting on Oct 3, 2017:

1. Item 7.2 Report of the Committee on Committees and Elections

The Senate approved various appointments or reappointments to Senate Committees, Councils, etc. Chair Vaughn once again reminded members that, per the Policy File, each Senator must serve on at least one Committee.

2. Item 7.3 Report of the Faculty Honors and Awards Committee

The Senate approved the following requests for emeritus status:

- Douglas Deutschman, Professor of Biology; November 1, 2017; 20 years
- Alexis Koster, Professor of Management and Information Systems; December 30, 2017; 34 years
- Kathy S. Williams, Professor of Biology; August 21, 2017; 30 years

3. Item 7.4 Report of the General Education Committee

The Senate approved the following *new* requests in the report:

- AE 460A: Aerospace Engineering Applications (addition of existing course to GE/IV: Explorations of the Human Experience—B. Social and Behavioral Sciences)
- ENS 318: Sport, Games, and Culture (new course/IV: Explorations of the Human Experience—B. Social and Behavioral Sciences)
- HHS 350: Applied International Health and Human Services (change to course description/IV: Explorations of the Human Experience—B. Social and Behavioral Sciences)
- ME 490A: Engineering Design: Senior Project (addition of existing course to GE and change to course description and grading method/IV: Explorations of the Human Experience—B. Social and Behavioral Sciences)
- EUROP 435: Culture and Identify in Post-Community Europe (addition of existing course to GE/IV: Explorations of the Human Experience—C. Humanities)
- REL S 382: California Religion and Spirituality (new course; cultural diversity/IV: Explorations of the Human Experience—C. Humanities)

After extensive debate, the Senate approved delaying (until November) a vote on the two Engineering courses pulled from the GE report in September: CIV E 220 – Civil and Environmental Engineering Computer Applications and ME 202 – Computer Programming and Applications.

I note the following actions from the Senate meeting in October 3, 2017:

4. Item 5.2 Resolution/Development Implementation of Executive Orders 1100 (Revised) and 1100

The Senate approved a Resolution in support of one passed by ASCSU during its September Plenary; it a) seeks to delay implementation of Executive Orders 1100 (Revised) and 1110 to Fall 2019 at the earliest and b) requests that the Chancellor's Office engage in data-driven and genuine consultation with faculty, staff, and Senates throughout the CSU.

5. Item 7.5 Sense of the Senate Resolution/Reinstatement of AVP Joanna Brooks

The Senate approved a Resolution to immediately reinstate Dr. Joanna Brooks to her position as AVP / Faculty Advancement.
