EXECUTIVE ORDER 1110

- Chair Shultz defined and explained Executive Order 1110.
- Executive Order 1110 pertains to incoming Freshman and their respective Math and/or English remediation needs.
- CSU will no longer offer remedial, non-credit bearing courses for Math and English.
- Credit bearing courses will be offered instead to support the student in need of additional subject assistance.

EXECUTIVE ORDER 1100

- Pertains to General Education reform at CSU/SDSU.
- Eventual outcome to generate consistent G.E. across all CSU campuses.

STUDENT SUCCESS COMMITTEE AND COLLEGE STUDENT SUCCESS TEAMS

- There are ongoing meetings of the College Student Success Teams; one team in each college.
- Since the Undergraduate Council has one faculty member from each college on the Council, that faculty member could also sit on their respective College Success Team.

ERG

- The Enrollment, Retention and Graduation report (ERG) will be presented to the SDSU Senate after APP and Undergraduate Council analyze the report.
