2.3.1. Each spring the Faculty Honors and Awards Committee shall recommend one tenured, probationary or FERP faculty member from each college, including SDSU Imperial Valley and the Library, as well as one from the Division of Student Affairs and Campus Diversity, for an Alumni Award for the following academic year.

Secretary Fuller shared that while 30 T/TT faculty in SACD had been disenfranchised by the eligibility for the award, which will now be addressed by these proposed policy changes, there are also more than 1400 contingent faculty that are not eligible to be recognized.

Secretary Fuller requested that the Vice Chair of the Senate issue a referral to the Faculty Honors and Awards Committee to do a comprehensive review of all faculty honors and awards and make policy updates that can increase equity and inclusion for contingent faculty. This was agreed upon without objection.
