B = NURS 206L (Lab course for accreditation that is linked to NURS 397 Class); ENS 241B – PE Equipment

C = CIVE 218 Surveying with equipment, outside but on campus

D = MUS 170-189: These courses need to be offered to complete the orchestra and are stacked courses with upper division courses
