I approve the following actions from the Senate meeting on November 6, 2018.

1. Item 7.1 Academic Calendar for AY 2019-20

The Senate approved adoption of the revised Academic Calendar for AY 2019-20, which now includes our "experiment" with holding Sunday group exams (12/15/19; 5/17/20). If we run into unexpected problems with this year's rollout, we'll revert to the original calendar. The Senate will see one final version with changes that are editorial only -- a reformatting that more clearly shows our three Summer Sessions (S1, S2, T1).

2. Item 7.2 Committee on Committees and Elections

The Senate approved recent member appointments to both Standing Committees and other committees and councils (including the long-dormant Extended Studies Advisory Council).

CAL 301. Concepts and Ideas in Science and Technology Studies (3) [GE] (IV. Explorations of Human Experience B. Social and Behavioral Sciences). *New course*.

NURS 351. Exploring Healthcare in America (3) [GE] (IV. Explorations of Human Experience > B. Social and Behavioral Sciences). *New course*.

HUM 412. Science and the Humanities (3) [GE] (IV. Explorations of Human Experience→C. Humanities). *New course*.

4. Item 7.4 Report of the Staff Affairs Committee
